**General Details:** This is an individual competition normally played during the first weekends of December, January and February.

Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.

**Format:** Stableford

**H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap

**Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

Should the competition deem to be a non-qualifying event, due to the course being shortened by more than 100 yards, or more than two Temporary Greens being in play, then this will be identified on the notice board or in the Pro Shop.

*Mid Week Winter Stableford*

**General Details:** This is an individual competition normally played on a Tuesday and Thursday mid December, January and February.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.

**Format:** Stableford

**H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap

**Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

Should the competition deem to be a non-qualifying event, due to the course being shortened by more than 100 yards, or more than two Temporary Greens being in play, then this will be identified on the notice board or in the Pro Shop.

***Four Ball Better Ball***

- General Details:** This is a pairs competition normally played three times a year in February, August and September.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.
- Format:** Four Ball Better Ball - Stableford
- H'cap Allowance:** Each partner receives  $\frac{3}{4}$  of full playing handicap.
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes because it is a Better-Ball format.
- Players are allowed to choose their own playing partner.
- History:** This competition was introduced into the calendar in 2010 by the then Captain Terry Coulson.

### *Monthly Medal*

**General Details:** This is an individual competition normally played during the first weekend of each month from March through to November.

Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.

**Format:** Stroke Play

**H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap

**Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to enter the competition. The four qualifying rounds must have been played in the 12 months prior to the player's 1<sup>st</sup> match.**

**Format:** Match Play

**H'cap Allowance:** Nil

**Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.

The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during March.

All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.

If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.

### *Singles Knockout*

**General Details:** This is an individual knockout competition played between April and October.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Players must enter their name on the competition sheet prior to the competition closing date.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to enter the competition. The four qualifying rounds must have been played in the 12 months prior to the player's 1<sup>st</sup> match.**

**Format:** Match Play

**H'cap Allowance:** Full difference between the playing handicaps of the players

**Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.

The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during March.

All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.

If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.

**History:** The Sundial Trophy was donated by Hazlemere Golf & Country Club and first played for in 1983.

### *Seniors' Singles Knockout*

**General Details:** This is an individual knockout competition played between April and October.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap and who are **aged 50 or over before the closing date for competition entry**. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Players must enter their name on the competition sheet prior to the competition closing date.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to enter the competition. The four qualifying rounds must have been played in the 12 months prior to the player's 1<sup>st</sup> match.**

**Format:** Match Play

**H'cap Allowance:** Full difference between the playing handicaps of the players

**Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.

The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during March.

All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.

If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.

**History:** The Four Bouys Competition Trophy was donated by RG & E Hurst and T Richardson. It was first played for in 1998.

### *Four Ball Better Ball Knockout*

- General Details:** This is a pairs knockout competition played between April and October.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Players must enter their name on the competition sheet prior to the competition closing date.
- N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to enter the competition. The four qualifying rounds must have been played in the 12 months prior to the player's 1<sup>st</sup> match.**
- Format:** Match Play
- H'cap Allowance:** Back Marker to concede strokes to the other three players based on  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the difference between the full playing handicaps.
- N.B.  $\frac{1}{2}$  strokes or over to be counted as one; smaller fractions to be disregarded.**
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.
- The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during March.
- All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.
- If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.
- History:** The 4 Ball Knockout Trophy was donated by RD Bowman & WJ Webb. It was first played for in 1983.

### *Foursomes Knockout*

**General Details:** This is a pairs knockout competition played between April and October.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Players must enter their name on the competition sheet prior to the competition closing date.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to enter the competition. The four qualifying rounds must have been played in the 12 months prior to the player's 1<sup>st</sup> match.**

**Format:** Match Play

**H'cap Allowance:** ½ the difference between the aggregate playing handicaps of each side.

**N.B. ½ strokes to be counted as such.**

**Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.

The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during March.

All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.

If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.

**History:** The Dane-Dean Salver was donated by A MacDonald and first played for in 1983.

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *Flag Competition*

**General Details:** This is an individual competition normally played in February. The objective is to carry the flag as far as possible.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position.**

**Format:** Stroke Play

The first group will be provided with a flag from the Pro Shop. This is placed in the middle of the fairway, or on the green at the position where the ball finishes after the last stroke has been played against handicap. The flag is then marked with the name of the player who went the farthest.

Subsequent groups will carry the flag forward as necessary. Thus any player playing net sub-par golf will continue down the 19<sup>th</sup> fairway until all shots are used up. The winner is normally on the 19<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup> hole.

**H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap

**Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is not played over 18 holes.

**History:** The Flag Trophy was donated by B. S. Roake and first played for in 1984.

### *The Martin Shield*

- General Details:** This is a pairs competition normally played in early March.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.
- N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position.**
- Format:** Greensomes - Stableford
- A Greensomes is played with both players driving off then playing alternate shots to the green from the preferred drive.
- H'cap Allowance:** 3/8<sup>th</sup> of the combined full playing handicaps
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes.
- History:** The Martin Shield Greensomes Trophy was donated by Derek Martin and first played for in 1983.

# HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

## *Rotogrove Plate*

- General Details:** This is a pairs competition with a handicap limit normally played in March.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.
- N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position.**
- Format:** Four Ball Better Ball - Stableford
- H'cap Allowance:** Each partner receives  $\frac{3}{4}$  of full playing handicap to a maximum of 18 strokes. (i.e players with a playing handicap 25 and above play off 18)
- Competitors with a playing handicap of over 18 can still enter the competition but are restricted to receiving a handicap allowance of 18 strokes for competition purpose.
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes because it is a Better-Ball format.
- Players are allowed to choose their own playing partner.
- History:** The Rotogrove Plate was donated by Gary Wood and first played for in 1983.

# HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *Texas Scramble*

**General Details:** This is a team competition normally played in May. The teams, comprising of four players, are drawn at random and allocated a starting position on the course. The competition begins with a shotgun start at 09.00.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position.**

**Format:** Stroke Play

This competition is played as follows:-

- All four players tee off and choose which of the four drives to play. The player whose ball is chosen marks the spot and hits first. All other players, in turn, either place their ball within six inches of the spot (if hitting from the fairway) or drop their ball within one foot of the spot if hitting from the rough. The order of playing for the remaining three players is the highest handicap first down to the lowest handicap player last.
- This format continues to the green at which time all four players putt from the position of the chosen shot to the green. The score for the hole is that achieved by the first ball to be holed. You cannot sink a short putt for the par and allow one of your partners to go for the birdie knowing that a par has already been scored. The same rule applies regarding order of play as for fairway shots.

**H'cap Allowance:** 1/10<sup>th</sup> of combined full playing handicaps.

**Special Note:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes.

To ensure that you will have a full team you are strongly advised to make contact with your fellow team members before the event.

**History:** The Texas Scramble Trophy was donated by J. Griffin and first played for in 1983.

## *Morrison Cup*

**General Details:** This is an individual competition normally played in May.

**Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.

Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.

**N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position. However, a player may enter the competition so that it may count towards the total of qualifying rounds for eligibility for future Board & Trophy competitions.**

**Format:** Stroke Play

**H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicaps

**Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

**History:** The Morrison Cup was donated by Brian Morrison and first played for in 1983.

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *Senior Challenge Salver*

- General Details:** This is an individual competition, with a handicap limit, for Senior members played over two rounds normally in June.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap and who will be **aged 50 or over as at the 31<sup>st</sup> December** in the current year. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- N.B.** **This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position. However, a player may enter the competition so that it may count towards the total of qualifying rounds for eligibility for future Board & Trophy competitions.**
- Format:** Stableford
- The competition is played over two rounds.
- The playing order for the second round will be in ascending stableford points from day one results, i.e. the leaders from day one go out last.
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap to a maximum of 18
- Competitors with a playing handicap of over 18 can still enter the competition but are restricted to receiving 18 strokes for competition purpose.
- Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes and full handicap allowance is used for calculating handicap adjustments.
- If a player's handicap changes between the two rounds, the player will play round two with the handicap current at the time of round two.
- Because of the limited number of people eligible to play in this competition, other golfers may enter their names on the starting sheet in Prime Time.
- History:** The Seniors Challenge Plate was donated by Roy Godliman and first played for in 1983.

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *Club Championship*

- General Details:** This is the Club's premier individual competition played over two days in mid-June. There is a **Gross** competition and a **Net** competition.
- Eligibility:** The Club Championship is open to all adult male members and intermediate members with a CONGU handicap and Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of nine or under. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee. Entries must be made before the competition Closing Date.
- N.B.** **This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position. These 4 qualifying rounds must be played in the year preceding the closing date of the competition.**
- Format:** Stroke Play
- The Championship is 36 holes played over two days.
- A draw is made for the First Round and is displayed on the Notice Board. If necessary later start times can be arranged with the Handicap Secretary - **WELL IN ADVANCE.**
- On day one, all players who have entered will play 18 holes. The order of play will be in ascending handicap order. At the end of day one, the best 60 gross scores plus ties, plus the best 10 handicap scores, if they are not already included in the top sixty gross scores, will go forward to day two. The playing order for day two will be in descending gross scores order from day one results, i.e. the leaders from day one go out last.
- H'cap Allowance:** Nil for the Gross competition.  
Full playing handicap for the Net competition.
- Special Notes:** **See also the special rules on the next page.**
- This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes however, handicaps will not be adjusted between rounds for competition purpose.
- History:** The Club Champion Trophy donated by Hazlemere Golf & Country Club and first played for in 1983.
- The Club Championship Handicap Cup was donated by Peter Cavie and first played for in 1984.

# HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *Special Rules for the Club Championship*

1. Practice on the course before either round or after the first round is strictly forbidden and will result in disqualification.
2. An updated handicap list will be available for the Championship.
3. It is each player's responsibility to ensure they have the correct current handicap on their scorecard.
4. It is each player's responsibility to know their tee time for both rounds.
5. A player wishing to withdraw **MUST** telephone the handicap secretary and not merely scratch their name out.
6. In the event of a tie for first place in the scratch section, a play-off will take place over 5 holes - the designated holes for this will be 10, 11, 16, 17 and 18. If this does not produce a winner, the sequence will be repeated but in a sudden death format.
7. In the event of a tie for the handicap section, the normal rules of count back for the second round will apply. However, in the extremely unlikely event of a count back not producing a winner, the players concerned will be joint winners.
8. Player's are required to complete the following on their card:-
  - Player's Name
  - Correct handicap
  - Gross score on each hole
  - Player's signature
  - Marker's signature.

Any cards not properly completed will be rejected and disqualification will result.

Players must refer to the handicap list to ensure that their correct handicap is recorded on the handicap list and scorecard.

9. It is the player's responsibility to know the tee time on each day. Tee times for day 2 will be available in the bar and on the website from approximately 19.00 on the Saturday night, or times can be obtained from either the Captain or the Competition Secretary.

- General Details:** This is an individual competition with a handicap limit normally played in September.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a **CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above**. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in the group.
- N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position. However, a player may enter the competition so that it may count towards the total of qualifying rounds for eligibility for future Board & Trophy competitions.**
- Format:** Stroke Play
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap to a maximum of 20
- Competitors with a playing handicap of over 20 can still enter the competition but are restricted to receiving 20 strokes for competition purpose.
- Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes and full handicap allowance is used for calculating handicap adjustments.
- History:** The Secretary's Challenge Cup was donated by Roy Godliman and first played for in 1983.

### *Committee Cup*

- General Details:** This is an individual competition with a handicap limit normally played in September.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a **CONGU playing handicap of nine or less**. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- N.B.** This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position. However, a player may enter the competition so that it may count towards the total of qualifying rounds for eligibility for future Board & Trophy competitions.
- Format:** Stroke Play
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.
- History:** The Committee Cup was donated by the Committee and first played for in 1992.

# HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *Winter Eclectic*

- General Details:** This is a series of competitions generally played over six rounds during the winter. The object is to achieve the lowest score on each hole over the six rounds thereby achieving the score for a complete round of eighteen holes. This is a **Gross** competition and a **Net** competition.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.
- N.B. This is a board competition therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position.**
- Format:** Stroke Play
- It is hoped that the competition can be completed before the worst of the winter weather sets in and is therefore subject to minor changes. The competition comprises a maximum of six rounds the dates of which are published annually.
- H'cap Allowance:** Nil for the Gross competition.  
 $\frac{3}{4}$  of playing handicap for the Net competition.
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes.
- Entry fees:** The entry fee is payable prior to the commencement of each round. Players must also sign the competition book before each round. Non-payment of the entry fee will result in the card being ignored. The ball sweep will apply as in any normal competition.
- Winners:** The winners will be those players with the best gross and net score - but no player may win two prizes. For the calculation of the net score, the stroke allowance will  $\frac{3}{4}$  of the player's full handicap on the last day of the competition. Where players are placed in both competitions the Gross competition will be considered the primary one and as such, prizes will be determined as follows Gross 1st; Gross 2nd; Gross 3rd. These players will then not be eligible for prizes in the Net competition. Tie resolutions will be determined by card count-back as detailed in Section 6.7.
- History:** The Winter Eclectic Scratch Trophy was donated by The Walter's Group and first played for in 1984.  
The Winter Eclectic Handicap Trophy was first played for in 1984.

*Steve Norgate Order of Merit*

**General Details:** The Order of Merit is determined by awarding points for the first three positions in all weekend medal competitions from March through to October.

**Eligibility:** All entrants to the monthly medals are included in the order of merit table which is displayed on the competition notice board.

**Format:** Stroke Play

**H'cap Allowance:** N/A

**Special Notes:** Points are awarded for the first three positions for both the Saturday and Sunday Medal competitions from March through to October.

Points are awarded as follows:-

1 <sup>st</sup> place	6pts
2 <sup>nd</sup> place	4pts
3 <sup>rd</sup> place	3pts

There is no count-back in respect of positions so joint positions gain the same points.

**History:** The Order of Merit Trophy was established as a memorial to Steve Norgate who sadly died on the course in 2001. His friends donated the trophy and it was first played for in 2002. In addition to the Trophy his friends also donated the bench on the 6<sup>th</sup> tee in his memory.

## COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

### *The PJ Putter*

- General Details:** This is an individual Bogey competition played with a limited number of clubs and normally played in late March/early April.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to **all categories of male members** with a CONGU handicap. 5-day members and RAF corporate members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Junior boys with a CONGU playing handicap of 10 and above must play with at least one adult member in their group.
- N.B. This is a trophy competition and therefore the 4-qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) rule applies for eligibility to win a Prize Winning Position.**
- Format:** Match Play
- This is a bogey competition played with a limited number of clubs.
- The putter and any three other clubs may be used.
- A bogey competition is a competition against the course.
- a net birdie wins the hole,
  - a net bogey loses the hole and
  - a net par halves the hole.
- At the end of the round, as in any match play, players are either up by a number of holes, level, or down by a number of holes.
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes because it is a match play competition and there is a restriction on the number of clubs that can be carried.
- History:** Trophy was donated by Peter Cavie and Jack Treble and first played for in 1983 and last played for in 2005
