Junior Christmas Trophy

General Details: This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday in early January during the school holidays.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- to be eligible to enter the competition players must have played 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) in the 12 months prior to the players' competition day.
- players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are not eligible to enter the competition.

Format: Stableford

H'cap Allowance: Full playing handicap

Special Notes: This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

This competition counts towards Penn Points.

History: The Junior Christmas Competition Trophy was donated by Hazlemere Golf & Country Club and first played for in 1992.

Junior Winter Stableford

General Details: This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday during February half term.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

Format: Stableford

H'cap Allowance: Full playing handicap

Special Notes: This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

This competition counts towards Penn Points.

Junior Matchplay

- General Details:** This is an individual match play competition normally played over two weekend days in March.
- Eligibility:** Eight players are invited to play all being previous Isis League team players. Two wildcards are chosen by the Junior Organizer. A draw will take place from other Juniors with an **Active** CONGU handicap who wish to play. In all a maximum of 16 Juniors participate.
- Format:** Match Play
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** On the morning of the 1st day a draw is made in the clubhouse to establish the 1st round pairings.
- The competition has four rounds and each round is played over nine holes. The winner of each match goes forward to the next round. If a match is tied then a putting competition is held to determine the winner.
- The first and second rounds are played on the first day and the remaining 4 players play in the semi-final and final on the second day.
- This competition is used as an indicator of form for the Isis League.
- This competition counts towards Penn Points.

Junior Country Club Cup

General Details: This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played during the Easter holidays.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- to be eligible to enter the competition players must have played 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) in the 12 months prior to the players' competition day.
- players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are not eligible to enter the competition.

Format: Stableford

H'cap Allowance: Full playing handicap

Special Notes: This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

This competition counts towards Penn Points.

History: The Junior Country Club Cup was donated by Hazlemere Golf & Country Club and first played for in 1989 or 1992.

Junior Spring Medal

- General Details:** This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday during the May half term.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.
- Format:** Stroke Play
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.
This competition counts towards Penn Points.

HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

Junior Singles Knockout

General Details: This is an individual knockout competition played between May and October.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

Players must enter their name on the competition sheet prior to the competition closing date.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- to be eligible to enter the competition players must have played 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) in the 12 months prior to the players' 1st match.
- players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are not eligible to enter the competition.

Format: Match Play

H'cap Allowance: Full difference between the playing handicaps of the players.

Special Notes: This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.

The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during May.

It is the responsibility of the first named player of a match to make contact with their opponent to arrange the match.

All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.

If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.

History: The U.K.C.L. Shield was first played for in 1992.

HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

Junior 4BBB Knockout

General Details: This is a pairs knockout competition played between May and October.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

Players must enter their name on the competition sheet prior to the competition closing date.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- to be eligible to enter the competition players must have played 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) in the 12 months prior to the players' 1st match.
- players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are not eligible to enter the competition.

Format: Match Play

H'cap Allowance: Back Marker to concede strokes to the other three players based on $\frac{3}{4}$ of the difference between the full playing handicaps.

N.B. $\frac{1}{2}$ strokes or over to be counted as one; smaller fractions to be disregarded.

Special Notes: This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a match play competition.

The Knockout draw will be posted on the notice board during May.

It is the responsibility of the first named players of a match to make contact with their opponents to arrange the match.

All knockout rounds **must** be played by the date specified and the **Final round is played on Finals Day** in October.

If a player is in more than one final then the final may be played **before** finals day on a day agreed by the Club Captain and Competitions Secretary.

History: The Junior Secretary's Shield was first played for in 1998.

Junior's Invitation Michael Reeve Trophy

- General Details:** This is an invitational Stableford competition for Juniors where a junior plays with an 'invited' member. It is normally played during the afternoon of the first Sunday in July.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap. The junior member is to invite one adult or intermediate member to be his or her partner.
- Format:** Four Ball Better Ball - Stableford
- H'cap Allowance:** Each partner receives $\frac{3}{4}$ of full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a Four Ball Better Ball competition.
- The competition is followed by a meal in the evening usually paid for by the adult.
- History:** The idea to introduce this competition into the calendar came about in the early days of the golf club as the junior section became quite successful in attracting new members, as it still does today. With the increase in players on the course, certain senior members started to voice their opinions about the juniors' etiquette, after all, golf is a social game that has rules. To be placed in an environment with little or no knowledge and no particular people to teach them was obviously difficult for juniors, therefore, it was decided to instigate a competition where juniors would invite a member to play with them.
- For the social side, the original format was to put the onus on the juniors to invite a member, not of their own family, to partner them in the competition, thereby learning to mix with other members. For the rules, it was hoped that the senior member would pass on the mores of the game of golf.
- Over the years golf has become less elitist and more people want to, and can, play, so the format changed with the growing confidence of both the junior and senior members in one another. Unfortunately, not every body has the ability to play golf, Michael Reeve being one. Therefore Michael donated a trophy in 2000 for the juniors to show the seniors just how good they are.

HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

Junior Club Championship

General Details: This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played over two weekdays early in the school summer holidays.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- **players with 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) played in the 12 months prior to the closing date of the competition are eligible to win a Prize Winning Position in both the Nett and Gross competitions.**
- **players without 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) played prior to the closing date of the competition are eligible to win a Prize Winning Position in the Gross competition but are not eligible to win a Prize Winning Position in the Nett competition.**
- **players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are eligible to win a Prize Winning Position in the Gross competition but are not eligible to win a Prize Winning Position in the Nett competition.**

Format: Stoke Play

H'cap Allowance: Nil for the Gross competition
Full playing handicap for the Nett competition

Special Notes: This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

The Gross and net scores count towards Penn Points.

There is a meal after the 2nd round of the competition.

History: The Junior Champion Trophy was donated by Hazlemere Golf & Country Club and first played for in 1983.

The Junior Championship Handicap Winner Cup was donated by Doug Manocha and first played for in 1983.

Junior Summer Plate

General Details: This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday early in the school summer holidays.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- to be eligible to enter the competition players must have played 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) in the 12 months prior to the players' competition day.
- players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are not eligible to enter the competition.

Format: Stableford

H'cap Allowance: Full playing handicap

Special Notes: This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

This competition counts towards Penn Points.

History: The Summer Plate was donated by the Ladies Section and first played for in 2004.

Junior Captain's Plate

General Details: This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday during the school summer holidays.

Eligibility: The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active CONGU** or Junior Club handicap.

N.B. This is a Board/Trophy competition therefore:-

- to be eligible to enter the competition players must have played 4 qualifying rounds (excluding N/R rounds) in the 12 months prior to the players' competition day.
- players with an Inactive CONGU handicap are not eligible to enter the competition.
- the competition to help gain an Active CONGU handicap.

Format: Stableford

H'cap Allowance: Full playing handicap

Special Notes: This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.

This competition counts towards Penn Points.

History: The Captain's Plate was donated by Martyn Taylor and first played for in 1989.

Junior August Medal

- General Details:** This is an individual competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday during the school summer holidays.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive CONGU** or Junior Club handicap.
- Format:** Stroke Play
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is qualifying for handicapping purposes.
This competition counts towards Penn Points.

HAZLEMERE GOLF CLUB COMPETITION RULES & CONDITIONS

Vets & Juniors Texas Scramble

- General Details:** This is a team competition open to all Juniors and Veterans normally played on a weekday during the school summer holidays.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap and any male Veteran with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU handicap. 300 Club members must pay the relevant Green Fee.
- Format:** A Texas Scramble with a team of 3 players (2 Juniors and 1 Veteran).
- H'cap Allowance:** 1/6th of combined playing handicaps.
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes.
This competition counts towards Penn Points.
- History:** The Vets/Junior Texas Scramble Trophy was first played for in 2005.

Junior Texas Scramble

- General Details:** This is a team competition open to all Juniors normally played on a weekday during the school summer holidays.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap.
- Format:** A Texas Scramble with a team of 3 or 4 players depending on the size of the entry field.
- H'cap Allowance:** For teams of three - 1/6th of combined playing handicaps.
For teams of four – 1/10th of combined playing handicaps.
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes.
This competition does not count towards Penn Points.

Junior Fun Day

- General Details:** This is a pairs competition open to all Juniors and Adults normally played on the last weekend of the school summer holidays. The aim is to raise money for the Junior Section and for the Juniors to have fun before going back to school.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap and any adult member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU handicap. 300 Club members must pay the relevant Green Fee if the competition is played at the weekend. A golfing parent, who is not a member of Hazlemere Golf Club, is also eligible to enter the competition.
- Format:** Four Ball Better Ball.
- H'cap Allowance:** Each partner receives $\frac{3}{4}$ of full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes.
- The Theme for the day is agreed at the Junior Committee meeting and the dress code is relaxed for the day.
- After the competition there is a meal, chosen to fit the theme for the day, and the Trophy Room is also decorated to fit the theme.
- The adult normally pays for the Junior's competition entry fee.
- This competition does not count towards Penn Points.

This competition counts towards Penn Points.

- General Details:** This is a team competition where a Junior team plays against a Ladies team and is open to all Juniors and Ladies. It is normally played on a Wednesday during the October half term holidays.
- Eligibility:** The competition is open to any Junior member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU or Junior Club handicap and any female member with an **Active or Inactive** CONGU handicap. 300 Club members must pay the relevant Green Fee if the competition is played at the weekend.
- Format:** Aggregate Stableford
- The winning team is the team with the greatest number of aggregate stableford points.
- H'cap Allowance:** Full playing handicap
- Special Notes:** This competition is non-qualifying for handicapping purposes as it is a team competition.
- This competition does not count towards Penn Points.
- There is a meal after the competition, paid for by the Ladies, and the winning team is presented with the Trophy.
- History:** The Ladies v Juniors Trophy was donated by Barbara Prole and first played for in 1994.
