

# Code of Conduct for Young Golfers

**This Code of Conduct has been designed to ensure that all young golfers have a sound understanding of the minimum standards expected of them when participating in golfing activity. All young golfers should strive to meet the code at all times.**

- All golfers must be able to participate in golf without fear of ridicule, harassment or restriction.
- Other golfers should be treated with the same respect and fairness you would like them to show you.
- Demonstrate fair play both on and off the course. Differences in gender, disability, culture, race, ethnicity, age, sexual orientation, and religious beliefs between yourself and others should be respected.
- Look out for yourself and the welfare of others.
- Do not engage in any irresponsible, abusive, inappropriate or illegal behaviour.
- Report any behaviour of other's that falls below the standards expected by the golf club.
- Speak out if you have concerns about anything involving your own needs or the needs of others.
- Be organised and on time.
- You must not leave the facility during a competition for any reason without first informing your Junior Organiser or the Club Professional.
